



## REMINDER OF THE UPPER MERION TOWNSHIP SNOW REMOVAL ORDINANCE

Upper Merion Township has established clear guidelines for snow removal. Property owners and businesses that use private snow-removal contractors are responsible for ensuring that all work is completed in accordance with the Township's Snow Removal Ordinance.

Township Code Chapter 137 (§137-1) states that it is unlawful to throw, shovel, push, or plow snow into, across, or onto roads, streets, sidewalks, or Township rights-of-way if the snow is intended to remain in those areas.

Property owners and businesses will be held responsible for snow placed into roadways, onto sidewalks, or within Township rights-of-way by residents or private contractors. These actions can create unsafe conditions for motorists and pedestrians.

Failure to follow these regulations may result in enforcement action, including fines of up to \$1,000.
